- **Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing English Language Proficiency Assessments- Kindergarten:** January 3rd, 2024-March 1st, 2024; **Grades 1-8:** January 16th, 2024-March 1st, 2024
- **English Language Arts and Math Assessments:** March 24th, 2025-May 6th, 2025
- **Science Test:** March 24th, 2025-May 6th, 2025

Quest Academy's Testing Security Plan is located in the Principal's office as well as the Student Success Administrator's office. The security plan includes information regarding the storage of testing materials, test administration and security training for school personnel, accommodations, and other procedures. The security plan also contains protocols for reporting and investigating irregularities in testing administration and testing security.

In the event of any alleged or suspected breach of test and/or examination security or unauthorized disclosure of test and/or examination content, this sequence must be followed:

- The situation must be reported to the school test coordinator and site administrator within 24 hours.
- The test coordinator or site administrator must, in turn, report the breach of test security or disclosure to the designated state administrator.
- For all alleged breaches of test security or irregularities in test administration for state-mandated assessments, the site administrator or test coordinator must submit the completed Report of Test Irregularity to the Nevada Department of Education within 14-days of the discovery of the event.
- For all alleged breaches of test security or irregularities in test administration for the state-mandated assessments, state administrators will investigate and determine appropriate consequences. Such consequences may include, but are not limited to, the invalidation of test results, and the evaluation of the appropriateness of suspension or revocation of an educator's license.
